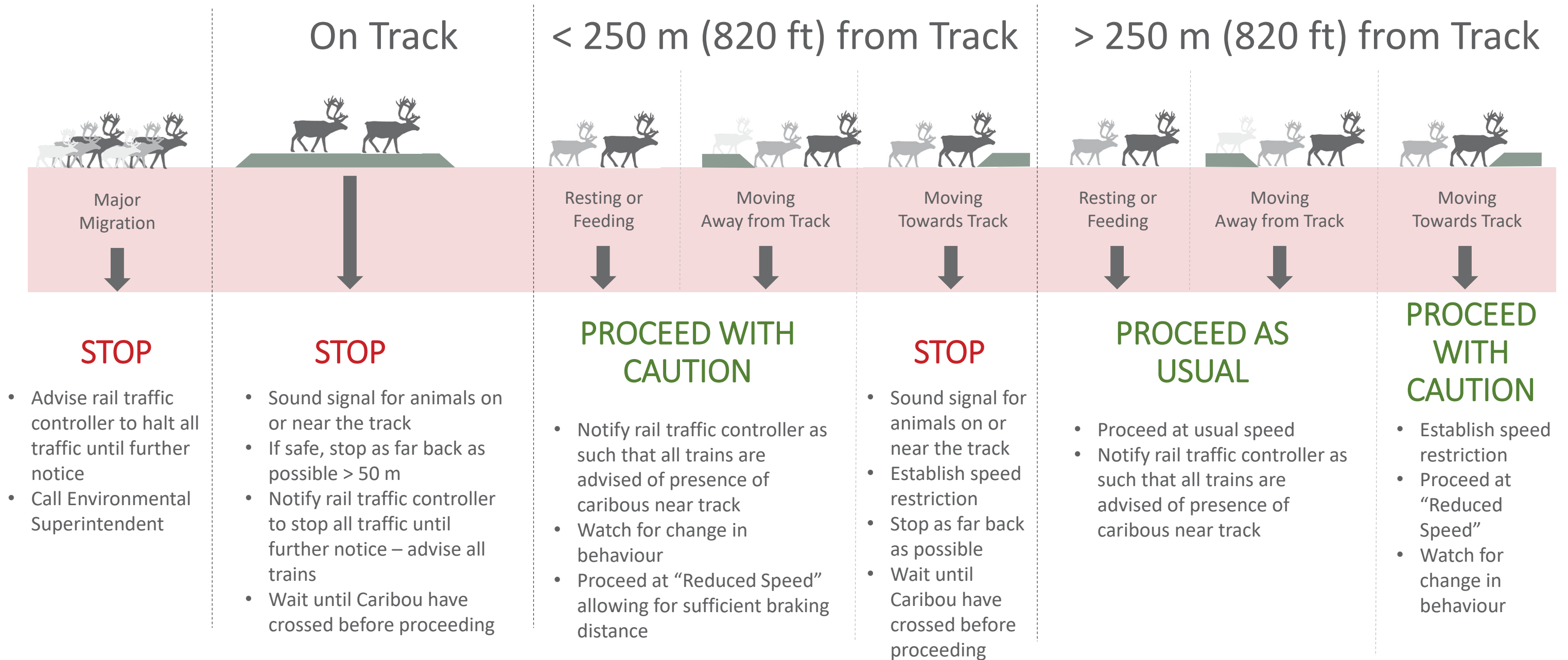


Caribou Decision Framework - Rail



- STOP**
- Advise rail traffic controller to halt all traffic until further notice
 - Call Environmental Superintendent

- STOP**
- Sound signal for animals on or near the track
 - If safe, stop as far back as possible > 50 m
 - Notify rail traffic controller to stop all traffic until further notice – advise all trains
 - Wait until Caribou have crossed before proceeding

- PROCEED WITH CAUTION**
- Notify rail traffic controller as such that all trains are advised of presence of caribous near track
 - Watch for change in behaviour
 - Proceed at “Reduced Speed” allowing for sufficient braking distance

- STOP**
- Sound signal for animals on or near the track
 - Establish speed restriction
 - Stop as far back as possible
 - Wait until Caribou have crossed before proceeding

- PROCEED AS USUAL**
- Proceed at usual speed
 - Notify rail traffic controller as such that all trains are advised of presence of caribous near track

- PROCEED WITH CAUTION**
- Establish speed restriction
 - Proceed at “Reduced Speed”
 - Watch for change in behaviour
