Brief description:

Awarded annually to a full-time student enrolled in the first, second, third or fourth year of a recognized program related to education, educational management, library studies, cultural studies, or a similar field. The candidate must demonstrate a commitment to a career in education, research, library studies, cultural education, or training.

Eligibility:

Open to Nunavut Inuit enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement. Priority will be given in the following order:

- 1. Inuit applicants from Hall Beach, Igloolik, Clyde River, Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay
- 2. Other Qikiqtani Inuit
- 3. Inuit from the rest of Nunavut

Application instructions:

We encourage all those interested in pursuing post-secondary education to apply for one of the scholarships, even if their area of study does not completely align with the description outlined above.
